



# Year 2 – Unit 5 – Science – Plants

| bulbs        |    | An underground bud or stem that stores food for a plant to use when it is in its resting stage.                       |
| conditions   |    | Plants require certain things to grow, stay healthy and survive, These are water, light and the correct temperature.  |
| flowering    |    | The part of a plant's lifecycle where it produces flowers to create new seeds.  |
| germination  |    | The process where a seed starts to grow into a young plant (seedling).  |
| growth cycle |   | The sequence of stages a plant goes through from a seed or bulb to a mature plant.                                    |
| seeds        |  | A small, protective casing produced by plants that contains a tiny, sleeping baby plant and the food to help it grow. |
| sprouting    |  | The stage where a seed begins to grow after being planted.  |
