We have considered several different structures and are confident that, within the context of our funding, this one will best meet the needs of the children. Where year groups are mixed, the classes have been set up based on the needs of the children within the cohort rather than split by age or attainment.

We mentioned last year that we have undergone a consultation with the Local Authority to reduce our intake from 45 children each year to 30 children; this started from August 2025. As we move towards a single year group structure, we may have to make further alterations to the class structures. These will always be considered very carefully and the curriculum will be adapted to reflect prior learning.
